> Regime

• E-Learning (self-study):

Attending the program in e-Learning (self-study): this regime is or adequate to participants who have completed one of the Bachelor programs offered by the DCT, who have successfully completed the course units on networks. This regime includes a few contact hours for clearing of doubts, lab work and exams.

The time needed to complete the program in this regime is estimated between 2 weeks and 6 months, depending on the amount of time that students spend at the Cisco e-Learning platform (multimedia resources).

e-Learning: 20 contact hours (including exams).

• B-Learning:

includes contact hours, theoretical and practical classes. 76 contact hours. Each ICND modules includes 35 contact hours (incl. practical and lab sessions).
