The Program on Advanced Studies in Geopolitics, a joint proposal by the National Defence Institute (Instituto da Defesa Nacional - IDN) and Universidade Autónoma de Lisboa (UAL), aims to provide participants with a deep understanding of the behaviour and interactions of Communities, States and Regions beyond the “froth on the daydream”.

The program combines “quantum satis”, physical, human and economic geography, with the laws of geopolitics, as well as History, Culture, Strategy, Political Science and International Relations, all under the serene, all present and never neutral gaze of the geographical scenario, where the lives of peoples develop.
