Structure

The Post-graduation in Experimental Archaeology (PEX) is divided into two levels. The basic level includes four course units and awards 24 ECTS. The advanced level includes two course units and awards 36 ECTS. Completing the first level allows access to the advanced level. PEX is offered using a hybrid model - the theoretical part of the program is lectured online; the practical sessions will be held in an intensive 7 full-day format. Moreover, students will be required to conduct theoretical and practical work. The ECTS obtained in the postgraduate course will be equivalent for the purposes of further studies in the Master's in Prehistoric Archeology and Rock Art.

Objectives

Provide specific and advanced practical training in Experimental Archaeology.
