## Structure

A Pós-Graduação em Direito das Migrações tem por objetivo ministrar conhecimento no domínio das migrações, um fenómeno internacional e complexo por natureza, que convoca uma abordagem pluridisciplinar, mas com uma forte componente jurídica.
