Structure

The Post-Graduation in Masonry and Initiation Societies focuses on some of the most important associations of this type in Europe and in the United States of America, on their origins and history, on the historical context and the institutional and political reasons that led to their foundations.

The Masonry, as the most representative society of its type and in view of the high number of Portuguese, European and American members, will be one of our core topics.

Other discussed societies include the Rosicrucianism, the Illuminati, the Carbonária and other.

The program is organised so that participants have both a theoretical and practical perspectives, including visits to areas in Lisbon dedicated to mason rites and symbolism, visits to mason temples and the decoding of mason symbols..

Objectives

This program aims that participants acquire or further their knowledge in this field, still not widely disseminated but which has been rather influential in Portuguese, European and world history. The masonry has been part of many world events, from the trip to the moon to the French Revolution, from the human rights charter to the independence of the USA.
