The Post-graduation in Political Journalism aims to provide skills to the professional in political journalism in the context of cultural convergence: media convergence, participatory culture ad collective intelligence.

The eLearning regime allows participation by all those aiming to be journalists or who are journalists in national, local, or regional media channels in Portugal or in a Portuguese-speaking country.

The program includes a series of modules on a digital media project. Specialization in this field of journalism is therefore provided from a practical perspective, in the already referred media and language "cultural convergence".

The different sources, political journalism in the context of democracy and citizenship, the changes in political communication in which journalists, professionals, political actors, and citizens need new skills to inform and be informed are the topics relevant to make students/journalists able to deconstruct and reconstruct the political message in the media.

This post-graduation also includes several conferences with communication experts and professionals, which will allow students to discuss topics relevant for their professional performance.
