













#### Structure

In order to comply with the legal requirements laid down in the GDPR (General Regulation on Data Protection) and complimentary legislation, the program provides solid training on personal data protection, especially focusing on the use of videosurveillance systems, including cybersecurity. The program is taught by highly specialized lecturers.

### **Objectives**

Provide students with specific knowledge on the GDPR (General Regulation on Data Protection) and complimentary legislation on personal data information, especially on the use of video-surveillance systems by public and private institutions, as well as on the Legal Regime on Security and Cyberspace and complimentary legislation on cybersecurity.

### Who should attend

All current and future Data Protection Officers, as well as administrators and other senior staff in public and private institutions who are responsible for Personal Data Processing, and those responsible for security already appointed or to be appointed within the scope of the Legal Regime on Cyberspace Security. The program is also especially relevant for those dealing with videosurveillance systems, institutions required to be registered since they conduct activities related with Private Security (those installing security systems) and design, maintain, install and provide technical assistance service to videosurveillance systems The program is also appealing to those who hold or aim to hold a position in Private Security or a similar area, particularly those holding or aiming to hold the position of security director, security liaison officer for critical infrastructures, those responsible for self -protection services, financial institutions, companies managing large commercial areas, use of cannabis for medicinal purposes, locations with spaces for dancing, as well as security managers for sports events and those aiming to become trainers in private security.
